Count Me In – Maths for Parents

The Count Me In team will be running a series of **FREE** maths classes for parents to increase their confidence and skills in helping their children with numeracy. Learning will be based on the Primary maths curriculum from P1 through to P7/early secondary and will equip parents with effective tools and strategies they can use to support various aspects of their child's numeracy development.

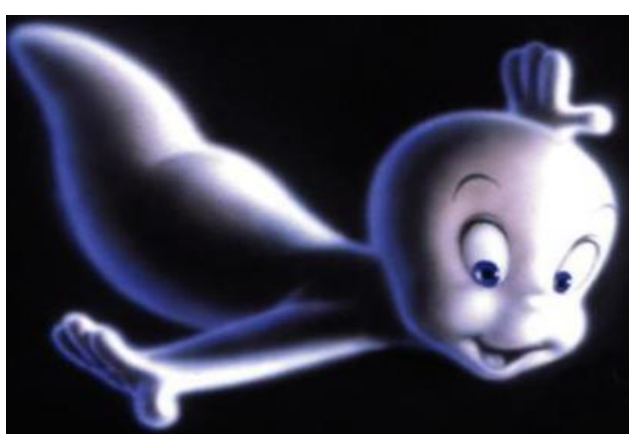
