### **Community Response Volunteer Location Home based** **Minimum Age 16 years**



G64 (Bishopbriggs, Auchinairn & Torrance) Community Support are looking for Volunteer Coordinators/Administrators. You will be required to have your own laptop/iPad and full training and support will be provided. You will be on a rota with other admin/coordinator volunteers and will only be required to volunteer one day a week although holiday cover may be required from time to time. Expenses will be paid

### **Retail Volunteers Location Milngavie, Kirkintilloch** **Minimum Age 14 years**



As a Barnardo's Volunteer you will help serving customers, pricing and displaying goods, providing excellent customer service and you may be required to sort customer donations. No experience is necessary as training will be given. This opportunity is ideal to gain valuable retail experience and a reference for employment or for your personal statement

### **First Aid Cadet Location: Kirkintilloch Minimum Age – 11 years**



St Andrew's First Aid Cadets take part in a full programme of first aid training and activities. This enables you to learn important life skills in a fun and safe environment appropriate to your age and gain the Cadet First Aid Certificate Level 2. St Andrew's First Aid Cadets are aged between 11-15 years and can move onto the adult section once they are 16. You will carry out team building exercises and on some occasions, can accompany first aiders to 'observe' them on duty. You can also go on to further national awards and competitions. Training is initially 6-8 weeks with ongoing training after that.

### **Youth Helpers Location Across East Dunbartonshire** **Minimum Age 14 years**



Girls/Boys Brigade operates a programme of physical, educational, spiritual and service activities for young people. By volunteering with the local company you would, under guidance, work with young people on a weekly basis, in a variety of settings. You will have the opportunity to discuss with leaders what skills you have and what you want to develop so that your time can be used effectively. By giving a couple of hours each week you can contribute to the local community by helping young people to develop skills and self esteem while at the same time expanding your own horizons through access to the Duke of Edinburgh Award Scheme and Saltire Awards.
